Write a letter to a character in the book.	Act out the part of the book that was your favorite.	Listen to an audio book or watch an ebook.

Write a book review. Make sure you give it a Rating. How many stars would it get? Why?	Draw your favorite scene from the book.	Create a book trailer or commercial for the book on flipgrid. You may include a "catchy" jingle (song).
Compose a poem about a place, something or someone in the book that inspired you.	Make a comic strip about one of the chapters.	Under parent supervision, schedule a <i>Google Meet</i> with a friend to talk about a book you read. It could be the same book or different books.
Compare and contrast two books you read. Use a T-chart, a Venn Diagram or write down notes.	Create a totally new cover for the book using any art tools (Chalk, watercolors, paper collage, crayons, markers, gray scale with pencil. etc.)	Use <i>Google Earth</i> to locate a place mentioned in a book you read. It could be a country, city, building, etc.)
