Talk about or write about the problem and solution in the book.	Reader Theater: Give a performance for a part of the book by reading it out loud with feeling and adding appropriate noises.	Create a 3-part comic strip with the beginning, middle and end of the book.
Scavenger Hunt: Find 3-5 things in the home that are connected to the book. Explain how each piece is connected to the characters or the story.	Up-cycle: Create something 3D in the book with whatever you have in the home. Ask for permission before you use it!	Take (draw) a selfie where you are part of a scene in the book.
Pretend you could talk with one of the characters. What would you say to him or her? Why?	Create a commercial for the book and act it out as if you were on TV.	Under parent supervision, schedule a Google Meet with a friend to talk about a book you read. It could be the same book or different books.
